Financing

PROPEL is funded by the Government of Canada's Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development (DFATD) and CHF.

DFATD has committed CAD 19M and CHF CAD 1M

Goal

to increase the value of Caribbean-grown fresh produce reaching high-value markets by \$100 million over 5 years, in the process positively affecting the livelihoods of up to 28,000 Caribbean producers across the region.



Challenges to Agro Processing in Guyana

- High cost of Energy
- Unreliable supply of local raw materials
- Low levels of technology
- Small operators (mostly women and youths)
- Inadequate support services
- Inability to benefit from economies of scales
- ❖Poor competitiveness of sector.







PROPEL's Rationale for Supporting Agro Processing in Guyana

- To reduce NTB for exports
- To increase competitiveness of sector locally
- To increase consumption and sales of local produce
- To support access for local produce to nontraditional markets



PROPEL's Rationale for Supporting Agro Processing in Guyana (Con't)

- To develop and support initiatives aimed to enhance women and youths participation in agro processing locally
- ❖ To expand markets .

- Product packaging development

- Improved competitiveness
