Exporting Fruits & Vegetables and Processed Items

In order to export fresh Fruits & Vegetables from Guyana to any Caribbean Country and the USA, you will need to obtain an import permit from the agricultural department of the respective country. This document must indicate the name and quantity of the items that you are allowed to export to the respective country. Persons desirous of exporting processed items do not need an import permit.

Once you have obtained the import permit you must register with the National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) which is located in Guyana School of Agriculture compound Mon Repos, East Coast Demerara. You may contact them via telephone on 220-5858 or 220-2456 where you will be registered.

After that is completed, in order for GMC to prepare your brokerage document you must present the following documents:

- 1. Copy of the Import permit (Not needed for processed items)
- 2. National ID or Passport
- 3. TIN Certificate

4. Proof of Address (Bank statements, utility bills...)

Note: An FDA registration is needed for persons exporting any food items to USA, this can be done by GMC.

Note the address on the TIN certificate and the proof of address must be the same.

Additional information that is required to complete the export the document:

The exporter must know the airline or vessel they are using to ship the commodity. They must provide the Brokerage Officer with the name, address and telephone number(s) of the person that the goods are being shipped to (Consignee), they must know the items that are being exported, the total weight in kilograms per item, the total amount of packages and the price per package.

Exporting Wood and Wood Products

In order to export wood and products from wood from Guyana to any Country the following documents are needed for GMC Brokerage service:

- 1. National ID or Passport
- 2. TIN Certificate
- 3. Proof of Address (Bank statements, utility bills...)

Note: An FDA registration is needed for persons exporting any food items to USA, this can be done by GMC.

Note the address on the TIN certificate and the proof of address must be the same.

Additional information that is required to complete the export the document:

The exporter must know the airline or vessel they are using to ship the commodity. They must must provide the Brokerage Officer with the name, address and telephone number(s) of the person that the goods are being shipped to (Consignee), they must know the items that are being exported, the total weight in kilograms per item, the total amount of packages and the price per package.

After the Brokerage Officer completes the export document, in cases where wood is used for large items or as sample pieces, the exporter takes the document to Forestry Commission, to be stamped and endorsed.
